## Rule Box

 Use "has" with:

 He, She, It, Singular noun

 Use "have" with:

 I, You, We, They, Plural nouns

 Example:

- She **has** a dog.
- They **have** two cars.

Has and have mean the same thing. They show possession. It means that a thing belongs to someone.

Example: I have a doll.

She has a badminton.
